

## **BEAUTICIAN**

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** This is moderately skilled work involving a responsibility for proper grooming of patients. The work may be done in a shop or at the bedside and is performed under general supervision. Does related work as required.

### **TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:**

Cuts and styles hair;  
Gives scalp treatments and shampoos hair;  
Cleans brushes, combs and manicure tools;  
Gives facial treatments;  
Keeps a file on patients, indicating services performed;  
Consults with nursing staff for special needs of patients;  
Supervises transportation of patients to and from beauty/barber shop;  
Requisitions and maintains supplies;  
May perform routine manicures.

### **FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:**

Good knowledge of modern practices, procedures, and techniques in hair grooming, facial treatments, and routine manicures; ability to establish and maintain cooperative relations with others, especially the elderly; ability to maintain simple files.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Eligibility for a license to practice cosmetology issued by the State of New York as evidenced by a temporary certificate to practice Cosmetology. Possession of a license at the time of permanent appointment.
